



The state of New York has very restrictive laws in place regarding the use of handguns by minors, even in a range facility setting. No person 15 years of age or under may shoot a handgun. American Marksman must follow these laws and will not allow any person 15 years of age or to participate in the handgun category at any range in the state of New York. This group of competitors may still register and compete in the Junior Rifle category.

Going further, the law states that all person ages 16 – 20 can fire a handgun in a range setting if the shooting session takes place in the presence of, and is under the control of, an NRA licensed instructor. Additionally, the legal owner of the handgun must be present.

As mentioned above, American Marksman must abide by these laws set forth by the state of New York.

We will monitor registrations for the Junior categories in the state of New York as they come in and we will reach out to the registrant to discuss options.

To repeat, this restriction only applies to the handgun category and has no bearing on the rifle category.
